Educational Goals

The Ledyard Board of Education has approved the following goal statements in order to direct the planning, operation, and evaluation of the educational programs under its jurisdiction.

It is recognized that advancement toward the achievement of the stated goals by students is dependent upon cooperation between the school system and the students' families.

It is further recognized that students learn from many sources, and a complete education is acquired by combining instruction that take place in the home and in religious and social institutions, with the formal school program.

Therefore, achievement of the stated goals must be attributed to the totality of a student's learning experiences.

Goal Category	Goal Statements
Leadership	The Teacher Effectiveness Performance Evaluation Handbook; the Ledyard Administrator Effectiveness, Professional Learning, and Performance Evaluation Manual; and the Ledyard Professional Learning Plan will be used to expand the leadership capacity of Ledyard Public Schools administrators and teachers.
Communication	The Board of Education will develop, implement and maintain a communication plan that will support the Vision and Mission of Ledyard Public Schools.
Technology	The District will maintain, support and improve the necessary infrastructure required for students and staff to utilize technology to enhance teaching and learning.
Curriculum	The District will revise and realign curricula to incorporate state and national frameworks to be reviewed by Instructional Council and reported to the Board of Education, and to align pedagogy with 21 st Century themes and skills.
