

SCHOOL DAY SCHEDULES

The Ledyard Board of Education is responsible for determining the manner in which each school within the Ledyard Public Schools District is operated including the format for the delivery of the educational program.

For the elementary schools, the Board shall delineate the amount of time to be devoted to instruction in each subject area of the curriculum.

For Ledyard Middle School and Ledyard High School, the Board shall specify the school day schedule (i.e., the number of periods, length of periods, etc.) to be followed at each school.

The Board recognizes that instructional time is critical to the educational achievement of each student and requires that interruptions to the approved educational program be limited. Therefore, the building Principal must obtain prior permission from the Superintendent to deviate from the approved school day schedule. In the case of an emergency, the building Principal should inform the Superintendent as soon as possible.
