

ONLINE COURSES and VIRTUAL CLASSROOMS

The Ledyard Board of Education believes that education through individual online courses or participation in virtual classrooms can be an effective means of instruction for students. These distance learning opportunities may be used to diversify course offerings for motivated students, to allow for completion of graduation requirements outside the formal school setting or schedule, or to provide for credit recovery for a student in danger of failing to graduate.

The Ledyard High School administration shall develop, with the Superintendent's approval, guidelines for evaluating the suitability of online courses to qualify in meeting graduation requirements.

The Superintendent shall keep the Board informed of the cost of providing distance learning opportunities for students.

The Superintendent shall designate, from among existing staff, an online learning coordinator to administer and coordinate the various distance learning programs at LHS.
