

Bylaws of the Board

Attorney

The attorney of the Ledyard Board of Education shall be the legal advisor of the Board and its officers in questions related to their official duties. The Board of Education may appoint, either on a full-time or retainer basis, an attorney or attorneys to serve as school attorney. The primary function of the attorney is to provide professional legal counsel and representation for the Board and Superintendent.

The attorney shall:

1. Represent the Board of Education in legal proceedings.
2. Give his/her written opinion on all legal questions referred to him/her by the Ledyard Board of Education or the Superintendent.
3. Attend Ledyard Board of Education meetings, conferences and other meetings as requested by the Board, Superintendent, Board chairperson or Board committee.
4. Fulfill such other legal duties as the Ledyard Board of Education may assign.

The performance of the school attorney(s) shall be subject to annual evaluation by the Ledyard Board of Education and the Superintendent.
