Community Relations

LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

The Board recognizes that District-wide cooperation with law enforcement agencies is essential for the protection of staff and students, for maintaining a safe environment in District schools, and for safeguarding District property. The Board supports the best possible relationship with those agencies consistent with District responsibilities to protect the legal rights of staff and students.

The Superintendent shall establish lines of communication with law enforcement agencies to effect necessary cooperation toward ensuring the security of the school facilities and the safety of staff and students.

Instructional programs and activities designed to enrich curriculum and to develop and promote good citizenship and a healthy attitude toward law enforcement agencies and officials will be initiated by the District. Law enforcement participation in such programs and activities is encouraged.
