

**Community Relations  
Firearms Prohibited on School Property**

The Ledyard Board of Education prohibits the possession of firearms on school property by students, staff and members of the public at all times, with the exception of Law Enforcement personnel in the performance of their duties or other individuals specifically authorized in writing by the Board.

The issuance of a legal permit, in accordance with the requirements of Connecticut General Statutes Section 29-28, to carry a pistol or revolver does not authorize the permit holder to possess or carry such pistol or revolver on school property.
