The Board recognizes that Ledyard is part of the global community and that its students must be prepared to participate in this larger social environment. Consequently, the Board requires that the district's curricula promote multicultural awareness among the students.

However, it is also the duty of the public schools to assist in helping the youth of our society in acquiring the beliefs, values, and attitudes that are at the core of the culture of the United States.

Therefore, while the instructional program shall promote tolerance and knowledge of the beliefs and values of other cultures, it must not do so at the expense of respect for and acquisition of the beliefs and values of the American society. The Board expects moderation, balance, and discernment in evaluating western and non-western cultures.
