

Instruction

Care of Instructional Materials

Library books, textbooks, and other educational materials are loaned to the students for their use, and shall be returned when requested by school authorities. Teachers shall emphasize to students that texts and materials are the public's property, and should be afforded proper care. Students must pay the full replacement cost of any book or educational material lost or damaged beyond ordinary wear.

Students who fail promptly to return or pay for texts and materials may have grades, transcripts or report cards withheld until restitution is made.
