

HOME EDUCATION OF CHILDREN

The Ledyard Board of Education recognizes the right of parents or guardians to educate their children at home in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes and regulations of the Connecticut State Board of Education. In doing so, parents/guardians accept sole legal responsibility for the education of their children, including the provision of special education services.

The Board does not permit home-educated children to attend Ledyard Public Schools on a part-time basis or participate in extra-curricular or co-curricular activities.

In the event that a home-educated student enrolls in Ledyard Public Schools, any past credit for home education will be determined as specified by the Superintendent.
