Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

CEU Equivalents

The Board will award CEU equivalents to its certified employees who hold a professional educator certificate for successful completion of professional development activities pre-approved by the Superintendent or his/her designee and carried out by a group or individual working in direct support of the district's goals and objectives. One CEU equivalent equals ten, 60-minute instructional periods. CEU equivalents shall not be awarded to activities for which the employee earns CEUs. The acquisition, not implementation, of skills, knowledge, and abilities in direct support of the goals and objectives of the district will be considered appropriate activities for earning CEU equivalents.

Teacher's Role

It is the responsibility of the teacher to maintain a record of his/her CEUs or CEU equivalents, earned during each consecutive five-year period, and for providing the State Department of Education with documentation of earned CEUs for updated certification.
