We certify that the above-named student(s) and parent(s)/guardian(s) reside with the host(s) at the above address seven (7) days a week, year-round, in a residence owned or occupied by the host(s) in the Ledyard School district. We understand that the Notarized Residency Affidavit is valid for the current school year only and must be renewed annually.

By signing below, we hereby give consent to the Ledyard Board of Education to investigate or obtain any information pertaining to the permanent residency of all pertinent parties. This may include a check with homeowners, landlords, case workers, utilities, governments agencies, housing agencies and/or any other agency regarding permanent residency in Ledyard, Connecticut.

We hereby agree to notify the school immediately regarding the termination of the student's full-time physical presence (permanent residency), in the town of Ledyard in which event the student will no longer be eligible for free school privileges. Finally, we understand that should the student be found to be attending Ledyard Public Schools illegally, the student will be immediately withdrawn from Ledyard Public Schools and the town of Ledyard reserves the right to recover the costs of such education from the host(s) and/or the legal guardians(s) of the student(s) listed above, and/or the student if age eighteen or older.

We understand that a perjured or fraudulent notarized statement may lead to prosecution under the criminal statutes of the State of Connecticut which is stated below (Larceny 53a122). We also understand that this document may be used as evidence in a court of law.

Larceny 1st Degree 53a122 – the property or service is obtained by defrauding a public community and such property exceeds \$2,000.

Class B Felony – not less than one year or more than 20 years and/or a fine up to \$10,000.

False statement to a public official, 2nd Degree: Class A misdemeanor punishable by up to one year in jail and a fine of up to \$2,000
